

1 Bøjden Nor

One of the south-west coast's best shore dives. Rich diversity of species throughout the year. From shrimps to many species of flatfish and pipefish. Really good beginners dive and good for UW photography.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
Leave the E20 motorway at exit 51 and drive towards Fåborg. From the roundabout outside Fåborg follow the signs for Bøjden. Around 1km before the ferry terminal turn left onto Dyndrogevej, and after driving another kilometre turn onto the gravel road that leads to the sea. It is possible to park 5m from the water's edge.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
From the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
Wide variety of marine life.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
No hazards.

**FACILITIES**  
None.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good macro photography.

2 Dive Spot M/F Ærøsumd

The M/F Ærøsumd ferry is a relatively young shipwreck. It sank in October 2014 following a controlled scuttling, and has now become the setting of one of the most interesting artificial reefs in Denmark. Good access points at all deck. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Ferry.

**DATA**  
Length 55.26m, width 9.32m. Height without mast 13m. Built 1959 at the Husumer Schiffswerft and started operating in 1960.

**DEPTH**  
6.5-19 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole ship.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
All year.

**SAFETY**  
The ferry has been properly secured for divers below deck in connection with overnight stays or when diving with Diving 2000.

**HOW TO GET THERE**  
From Rudkøbing drive along route 305 in the direction of Bagenkop. Around 5km south of Rudkøbing turn right along Klæsevej, and follow this road until it ends at a parking place next to the beach.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
10m from the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The under-water path.

3 The Svendborgsund Bridge

The pride supports and roundels make a good dive, plenty of life everywhere on the seabed.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
Crossing the bridge from Svendborg to Tåsinge, turn to the left at the first set of traffic lights, the immediately turn to the left again onto Bregningvej. After about 1km you will come to a fork in the road, again keep to the left turning onto Bratenevej. After a few hundred meters you will arrive under the bridge. Here you simply follow the gravel track down to the water.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
Under the south side of the bridge. Most dives take place on the Tåsinge side of the bridge.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The marine life, the varied sea bed and the numerous molluscs on the bridge pillars and roundels.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
All year.

**SAFETY**  
Always clearly mark your position with the dive 'A' flag as there is a lot of boat traffic in the Svendborg Sound.

**FACILITIES**  
None.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good macro photography.

4 Christiansminde

Fine shore dive close to town. Varied marine life all year round, good for macro photography.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
Take the motorway from Odense to Svendborg. Leave at junction 16 and follow the Ring Nord, route 163, towards Skårup. Turn right onto Ørbækvej, which later becomes Linkenærskovvej. This leads to a roundabout here, take the first exit. Drive around 600m to Hotel Christiansminde where you will find parking.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
From the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The marine life.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
The shipping lanes present a hazard.

**FACILITIES**  
Toilets and car park.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good macro photography.

5 The Thure Dam

An unusual drift dive with large rocks, covered in sponges, and various species of brown algae.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
Leave the motorway between Odense and Svendborg at exit 16 then head along route 163 "Ring Nord" towards Skårup. After a while you will come to a roundabout, here turn right onto Ørbækvej. Carry straight on until the road crosses over into Linkenærskovvej and then further on into Hestehavevej. Just before coming to the bridge to Thure stop at the parking place on the left.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
From the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The large stones with sponges and seaweed.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Spring and summer.

**SAFETY**  
Be aware of the dangers associated with boat traffic.

**FACILITIES**  
Car park.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good macro photography.

6 The E-boats (motor torpedo boats)

4 exciting German motor torpedo boats from the Second World War, plenty of history and interesting details. The shallow depth makes it a very good beginners dive. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Warships.

**DATA**  
Nationality German. Length 53m, width 8m. Built in 1937. Converted in 1939.

**DEPTH**  
23-27 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole ship.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
The bows, superstructure, engine details, torpedo tubes.

8 The Arete

A wreck sunk by a mine. It's cargo included rolls of paper which can still be seen on the seabed. Engine details also visible. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Steam powered freighter.

**DATA**  
Nationality Swedish. Length 50m, width circa 8m. Built in 1928.

**DEPTH**  
13-15 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole ship.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good wide angle subjects.

9 Spodsbjerg: North Beach

Just north of the ferry terminal, near the wooden posts for nets you can find plenty of marine life. Eels grass beds are home to pipefish and young fry all summer. Beautiful areas with sea lace and bladderwrack.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
From Rudkøbing drive towards Spodsbjerg. Just before the ferry terminal turn to the left onto Lekkeby Strandvej. After a few hundred meters you will pass a grey house, park around 50m later by the side of the road.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
5m from the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The many flatfish and pipefish.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer.

**SAFETY**  
No hazards.

**FACILITIES**  
None.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good macro photography.

10 Lindelse Nor

A marked under-water path off west Langeland with many prehistoric remains. Extensive eelgrass beds are full of life during the summer.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
From Rudkøbing drive along route 305 in the direction of Bagenkop. Around 5km south of Rudkøbing turn right along Klæsevej, and follow this road until it ends at a parking place next to the beach.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
10m from the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The under-water path.

11 The Skansen

The Skansen is also known as the Lilleballe wreck due to it's proximity to Lilleballe. A small, relatively recent wreck which is very intact. Often strong currents, but a good beginners dive when there is no current. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Dredger.

**DATA**  
Built in Holland in 1937. Length 26m, width circa 6m.

**DEPTH**  
14-18 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole ship.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
The stern, bows, wheelhouse.

12 The Bredbjerg Wreck

Old wooden wreck close to shore, accessible without a boat. Interesting details.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
Drive south along route 305 from Rudkøbing to Bagenkop. In Tryggevle turn left down Ourevej, which continues into Slåvængvej. Stop in the parking place at the end of the road.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
Swim out from the concrete manhole cover.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole wreck.

13 Østerskov Beach

Shore dive that quickly reaches a depth of a few meters close to shore. Many flatfish are often seen here during the summer. Belts of vegetation with bladderwrack and eel grass, with many small fish.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
From Svendborg drive towards Rudkøbing and then turn south down route 305 to Bagenkop. In Tryggevle turn left onto Østerskovvej. At the end of this road you will find a car park five meters from the waters edge.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
From the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The fish life.

14 Augustenborg / Unknown steamer

Broken up wreck with many interesting features. Good site for less experienced divers. The wreck can shelter cod and coalfish. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Steamer/trawler.

**DATA**  
Nationality unknown. Length circa 25m, width circa 6m.

**DEPTH**  
13-15 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The picturesque ribs and looking into the wreck.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good wide-angle possibilities.

15 M 36 / The Capsized

One of the biggest wrecks in the Langelands Belt. A German mine-sweeper from WWII. A very exciting wreck which is largely intact, with many interesting details. The screws are still in place. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Warship.

**DATA**  
Length circa 66.10m, width circa 8.70m. Built in 1940.

**DEPTH**  
22-28 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole wreck.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
There are many wide-angle subjects.

16 The Island

Attractive wreck, lying upright on a light coloured seabed. Often good visibility, the wreck is largely intact, although the bows were blow off and lie close to the wreck. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Armed trawler.

**DATA**  
Nationality German. Length 45m, width circa 8.5m.

**DEPTH**  
16-23 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole ship.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
The bows, superstructure, trawl-winchies etc.

17 The Steam Trawler

A small but exciting wreck, that has partly broken up. Good marine life and some engine parts and other elements of the ship. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Steamship.

**DATA**  
Length circa 30m, width circa 6m.

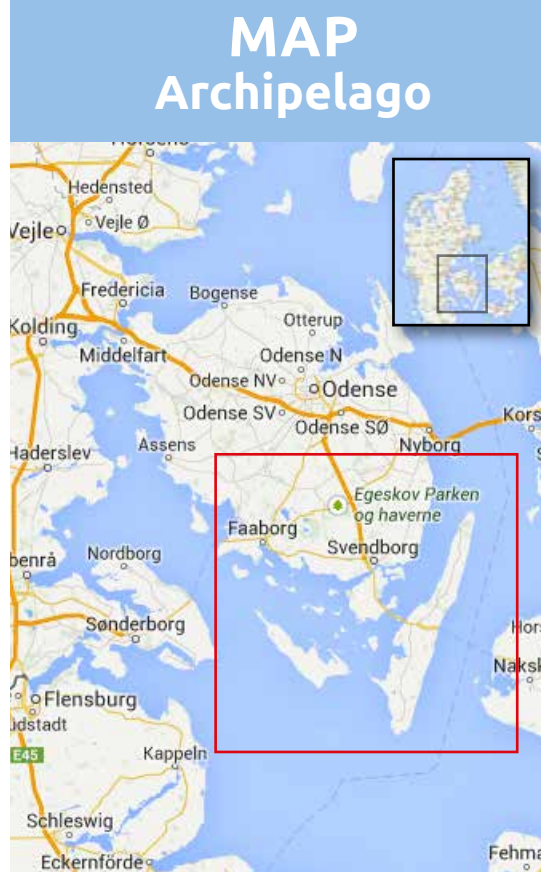
**DEPTH**  
14-16 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The front part of the ship.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
The bows and starboard side.



18 The Binz

A nice wreck lying at a depth suitable for beginners. It lies on the seabed in two parts. A number of artefacts have been recovered from this wreck. Today the wreck provides shelter for large fish. Boat Necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Former ferry, converted into a gunboat.

**DATA**  
Nationality: German.

**DEPTH**  
14-16 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The whole ship.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water. Bring SAGs and reels.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
The bows, hold, steering gear.

19 Dovns Klint

Clay and chalk seabed with many flatfish and small cod. Beautiful gullies and many seaweed beds.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
Follow route 305 south from Rudkøbing until you are nearly in Bagenkop. Around 1km before town make a left turn onto Gulstavevej which will take you all the way to Gulstav. There is a large parking place at the end of the road, next to Dovns klint.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
At the end of the path that starts by the toilets in the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The attractive sea bed and many flatfish.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
Fly the dive/A-flag. Be aware of anglers in the vicinity.

**FACILITIES**  
Toilet in the car park.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Primarily macro photography.

20 Keldsnor Lighthouse

Beautiful stoney reef close to shore. Many species of flatfish. Rarely any current.

**HOW TO GET HERE**  
From Rudkøbing follow the main road down to Bagenkop. Around 1km before town turn left down Gulstavevej towards Dovns Klint. Turn to your left down Fakkemo-sevej, and after a few hundred meters turn right down Rathvej. At the end of this road continue past the lighthouse down a gravel track until you reach a small parking place next to the beach.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING THE WATER**  
100m from the car park.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The varied marine life.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer and autumn.

**SAFETY**  
No hazards.

**FACILITIES**  
Car park.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Good macro photography.

21 The Torpedo Boat

A very beginner friendly wreck, as it is lying on a light colored, sandy seabed in 10 meters of water with rarely any current. The wreck is beautifully overgrown and many fish including cods may be seen under the stern of the ship.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Motor torpedo boat.

**DATA**  
Nationality German.

**DEPTH**  
10 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The wreck is beautifully overgrown where the engines can be clearly seen.

**BEST TIME OF THE YEAR**  
Spring and autumn.

**SAFETY**  
Be aware of ammunition spread on the seabed. You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
Yes.

22 The Tromp of Rotterdam

Large wreck, damaged exploding mine. Intact stern section. Often shelters large fish. Lies in deep water on a soft bottom. Bring lamps. Boat necessary.

**WRECK TYPE**  
Freighter.

**DATA**  
Nationality Dutch. Length 45m, width circa 7.6m. Built in 1932.

**DEPTH**  
23-28 meters.

**HIGHLIGHTS**  
The stern section.

**BEST TIME OF YEAR**  
Summer months.

**SAFETY**  
You must always fly the A-flag when diving, a boat handler should remain on board when divers are in the water.

**PHOTOGRAPHY**  
The wheelhouse and other features near the stern of the ship.
